Reflection

So where does that leave us? Today we have seen the start of a story. Certainly, we hear of the prophets saying that a Messiah is coming and that one will come who will announce Him but now it begins.

When the Angel came to Mary and then spoke to Joseph. When Zachariah was given his message in the Holy of Holies. A story begins. These two babies were going to shake the earth with a message so glorious so important that the world would be changed, not just a physical and scientific expansion but a message which would challenge and change the hearts of those who heard it. The world would never be the same again.

Within fifty years, even though both men were no longer with us in a physical, form the message they gave had started to spread across the world. It crossed seas and oceans, the highest of mountain ranges and the hottest and driest of desert. It was proclaimed in mighty cities, in small towns and villages, it was debated by scholars and loved by the untutored. For the unloved it brought love, for the anxious it brought a sense of peace, for the lost a sense of purpose. It became all things to all people in their time and in their need.
